


HOW TO FILE A PETITION FOR NAME CHANGE PURSUANT TO 54 P.S. §701-705.

Procedures for Filing a Petition for Name <u>Change</u>

Purpose:

The procedures set forth in this packet are provided as a guide to navigate the Judicial Name Change Process provided in 54 Pa.C.S.A. §701-705. This process can take up to 90 days and cost in excess of \$500.00 dollars.

ATTENTION!!!!

IF YOU ARE SIMPLY TRYING TO RESUME YOUR MAIDEN NAME AS A RESULT OF A DIVORCE OR A PENDING DIVORCE ACTION, YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO FILE A NAME CHANGE PETITION IN CIVIL COURT. YOU MAY RESUME YOUR PRIOR NAME BY FILING A PETITION TO RESUME PRIOR NAME. THE NECESSARY PAPERWORK IS AVAILABLE AT THE DEPARTMENT OF COURT RECORDS, CIVIL/FAMILY DIVISION. THE FILING FEE IS \$20.00. IF YOUR DIVORCE DECREE WAS GRANTED IN A DIFFERENT JURISDICTION, YOU CAN FILE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE FOREIGN DIVORCE DECREE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF COURT RECORDS. THE FILING FEE IS \$170.75.

Procedures for Filing a Petition for Name Change

- I. Obtain Fingerprint Card and complete a Petition for Name Change
 - a. When filing the Petition for Name Change, individuals 13 years of age or older must provide their fingerprints for a background check to be conducted by the Pennsylvania State Police. Children 12 or under are NOT required to have fingerprint cards.
 - b. There are several ways to obtain a fingerprint card. Whatever option is chosen, you must ensure you receive a physical copy of your fingerprints.

Note: The Court does not recommend any of the below services, nor is this list updated/verified to ensure these services are still available. This information should only be used as a guide. The Petitioner is responsible for obtaining a physical copy of their fingerprints.

- i. The Pennsylvania State Police barracks in Moon Township located at 449 McCormick Road. Moon, PA 15108 provides fingerprinting services. The hours are Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. However, you should contact them directly at (412) 299-1607 to confirm these dates and times and to ensure that someone will be available to take the fingerprints. This fingerprinting service is free.
- ii. The UPS Store in Oakland provides fingerprinting services for \$25.
- iii. John Godlewski. For a quote for services and/or appointment, you can contact him at (412) 337-6004 or visit http://www.premierfingerprinting.com for more information regarding his services.
- iv. IdentoGo Monroeville. PA Location and Green Tree, PA Location https://www.identogo.com/LOCATIONS/PENNSYLVANIA just be sure to confirm they can do fingerprints for a name change. You will need to leave with a paper fingerprint card in your hands. When scheduling online, chose "Fingerprint Card"
- II. Filing the Completed Petition and submitting the Fingerprint Card.
 - a. The Form Petition for Name Change is attached as Form 1 (Adults) or Form 2 (Minors). Parents seeking to change the name of their minor child are identified as

the Petitioner; e.g. John Doe, Parent and Guardian of Jane Smith minor, to change name to Jane Doe. It is very important to fill in all parts of the Petition form completely. Your Petition coversheet MUST contain your name, address, telephone number, and email address so that the Court can communicate with you.

- b. Once you have obtained the Fingerprint card and have completed the Petition for Name Change, you are ready to file the Petition with the Department of Court Records, which is located in the City-County Building, First Floor, 414 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15219.
- c. When filing the Petition, the Petitioner must provide the following:
 - i. A Fingerprint Card (if 13 years of age or older)
 - ii. A Completed Original Petition for Name Change and one copy.
 - iii. Three envelopes completed in the following manner:
 - 1. One stamped 8 ½" x 11" envelope addressed to:

PA. State Police Central Repository 1800 Elmerton Avenue Harrisburg, PA 17110

2. One stamped letter sized envelope addressed to:

Department of Court Records-Civil Division ATTN: Kim Zombeck First Floor City-County Building 414 Grant Street Pittsburgh, PA 15219

- 3. One stamped letter sized envelope addressed to the Petitioner, or his/her attorney where applicable.
- d. There is a filing fee of \$160.25 payable to the Department of Court Records for this filing. If you are unable to pay the filing fee, you may qualify to have those fees waived. If you are seeking to have the fee's waived, you must complete a Petition to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*. This form can be obtained from the Department of Court Records at the time of filing.

- e. The Department of Court Records clerk will assign a General Docket number to the completed Petition. This is an important number, and it will be used to track your case.
- f. When you file the Petition with the Department of Court Records, the fingerprints are submitted to the Pennsylvania State Police to obtain a criminal background check. [This is why you need to provide the large envelope referenced above.] Once the Department of Court Records receives the outcome of the criminal background check, a letter will be issued to either you or your attorney, when applicable.
- g. The letter from the Department of Court Records will instruct you to take the next important steps to have your name change petition heard and ruled upon by the Court. Specifically, you will be advised to:
 - i. Obtain a hearing date by emailing the Petition to civilnamechanges@alleghenycourts.us.; and
 - ii. Legally advertise the date and time of the hearing on your name change Petition.

III. Scheduling the Petition to be heard by the Court

- a. Once you receive the letter from the Department of Court Records, you are responsible for providing the General Motions Scheduling Team with a copy of the completed Petition. Make sure the General Docket number is shown on the Petition. Email your complete Petition exactly as you filed it, in its entirety, to civilnamechanges@alleghenycourts.us and request that a hearing be scheduled.
- b. In the email accompanying your Petition, you should state that you received a clean criminal background check and now you are asking that the Court enter the Scheduling Order setting a date and time for the hearing on your Petition.
- c. Upon receipt and review of your email, the Court will schedule the hearing by Order and send you a copy of the Order identifying the date and time of the hearing. You should receive the signed order within a week of emailing your Petition for Name Change to civilnamechanges@alleghenycourts.us requesting a hearing date.
- d. You will need to know the date and time of the hearing on your Petition for Name

Change to proceed with advertising the Petition as required by the statute. You will be required to advertise in the Pittsburgh Legal Journal, the official paper for publication of legal notices for Allegheny County, as well as one other newspaper of general circulation. Examples of newspapers of general circulation include the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette and the Pittsburgh City Paper.

IV. Advertising your Name Change Petition Hearing

- a. When the scheduling Order arrives, you must legally advertise the date and time of the hearing in the Pittsburgh Legal Journal and one other newspaper of general circulation. Examples of a "newspaper of general circulation" are the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette and the Pittsburgh City Paper. Forms for the Pittsburgh Legal Journal and the Pittsburgh City Paper can be found in this packet in Form 5. The Pittsburgh Post-Gazette has a webform which can be found at https://www.post-gazette.com/legaladvertisingdocs.
- b. After you have completed and submitted the forms, and paid the required fee, the Newspapers will advertise your name change. You will receive Proofs of Publication via regular mail or email, showing the legal advertisements have been done.
- c. Once you receive your proofs of publication, you should promptly file them with the Department of Court Records. These can be filed in person, electronically at dcr.alleghenycounty.us or by regular mail to the address below:

- d. It is recommended to file these in-person or electronically so there is no delay in processing your name change. If you choose to mail your Proofs of Publication, you must include a note with your General Docket Number so the Department of Court Records can file the proofs appropriately.
- e. For Minor Name Changes: In addition to publishing the name change, the non-petitioning parent or legal guardian <u>MUST</u> receive notice of the date and time of the hearing. The Petitioning party must do one of the following:

- i. The Non-Petitioning Parent/Legal Guardian can complete an Affidavit of Consent (Form 3) consenting to the name change of the minor; or
- ii. The Petitioning Parent/Legal Guardian must provide notice to the non-petitioning parent/guardian via Certified Mail/Return Receipt Requested and file a Certificate of Service (Form 4).
- f. If you know the non-petitioning parent will contest the Petition for Name Change of a Minor, you should immediately email civilnamechanges@alleghenycourts.us as contested Petitions for Name Change of a Minor shall be transferred to the Family Division per Local Rule 505(3)(e) using the included form.

V. Obtain your Judgment Search(s)

- a. The Judge presiding over your name change hearing must receive Judgment Searches from all counties in which you have lived for the past five (5) years no sooner than ten (10) days prior to the hearing.
- b. To obtain a certified copy of the Judgment Search for Allegheny County, you must return to the Department of Court records where you filed your Petition and ask the clerk to provide you with a certified copy of the Judgment search. There is a \$25.00 fee for the judgment search in Allegheny County.
- c. You should contact all other counties in which you have lived within the past five (5) years to obtain Judgment Searches from them immediately, as it can take longer to receive results from other counties.

Note: Some counties will not perform Judgment searches for out-of-county petitioners. In the event they will not perform a Judgment search for you, you should notify the court via email to <u>civilnamechanges@alleghenvcourts.us</u> so the appropriate language can be included in your final order.

d. Once you have completed all the necessary judgment searches, you must email all the Judgment Search documents to <u>civilnamechanges@alleghenycourts.us</u> for review. Please make sure you reference your GD case number in the email with your Judgment Search documents.

VI. Name-Change Hearing

æ

- a. On the date and time of the hearing set in the scheduling Order you may appear in Courtroom 703, City-County Building, 414 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15219.
- b. You are NOT required to attend the hearing. You may attend and obtain a courtesy copy of the final name change order.
- c. Your Petition for Name Change will be granted so long as you have:
 - i. Performed the required advertising;
 - ii. Filed the Proofs of Publication with the Department of Court Records;
 - iii. Obtained the required Judgment Searches; and
 - iv. For Minor's Name Changes-Filed an Affidavit of Consent, or a Certificate of Service indicating you served the Non-Petitioning Parent.
- d. Once the Final Order granting the Petition for Name Change is signed and Docketed, you will be provided with a copy via email.
- e. Minor's Name Change Hearings
 - i. Petition for Name Changes of a Minor will proceed in the same manner. However, if the non-petitioning parent appears on the date and time of the hearing, a final order will <u>NOT</u> be signed, and the matter will be transferred to the Family Division for all future proceedings.

VII. Obtaining Certified Copies

- a. To change all your official documents (birth certificate, social security card, passport etc.) you will need to obtain a certified copy of the Final Order Granting your Petition for Name Change.
- You can obtain the certified copy from the Department of Court Records. The fee for a Certified Copy is \$20.00 dollars.
